Itinerary

Jun 5 – Depart SFO – to Barcelona

Jun 6 – Arrive in Barcelona – We will get settled in our hotel and then have time at leisure.

Jun 7 - Discover the charm of the streets, squares, hidden corners and hundred-year-old buildings of Barcelona – This afternoon, board your cruise ship and meet your crew aboard beautiful Azamara Journey. **(B)**

Jun 7 – 14 Cruising aboard the Azamara Journey (B, L, D)

Jun 14 - Full day tour to Estroil/Cascais/Sintra. An unforgettable morning and afternoon to discover the “Sunny Coast” and it’s beaches. Cosmopolitan Estroil, the colorful Bay of Cascais and the picturesque cliff – Boca do Inferno (mouth of hell) Guincho beach. Continue onto Cabo da Roca – the westernmost point of Europe. Drive across the beautiful Sintra Mountains and its gardens to visit the charming Pena Palace. (stop for independent lunch) **(B)**

Jun 15 - Take a fascinating day trip from Lisbon to the Portuguese towns of Óbidos, Nazaré, and Fátima. During the day, explore the charming medieval village of Óbidos and learn interesting facts from your local guide. A visit to the picturesque fishing village of Nazaré, with a stop for independent lunch. Enjoy free time to visit the Sanctuary of Fátima, which celebrates the 1917 apparition of the Virgin Mary, one of the most important Christian sites in the world. On the way back to Lisbon, take in views of Portugal's lovely agricultural countryside. **(B)**

Jun 16 - This morning, a private transfer to the airport for our flight to Ponta Delgada, Sao Miguel – Azores. This afternoon tour includes a visit to the beautiful Twin Lakes of Sete Cidades and the pineapple plantation. Later in the evening enjoy a special typical dinner at Solar da Graca, including Folklore show. **(B, D)**

Jun 17 - Full day excursion –Depart from Ponta Delgada for a full-day tour of a visit to ceramic factories, with stops at viewpoints in Caloura, Vila Franca Do Campo and Furnas. Visit the Furnas lake and the hot springs. Lunch in Furnas town with typical Portuguese dish (Cozido). After lunch a visit to the Botanical Gardens. Visit the north shore of the island, stopping at the viewpoints, visit the Tea Factory and the Ribeira Grande City with its beautiful architecture. **(B, L)**

Jun 18 - This morning, a private transfer to the airport for our flight to Angra, Terceira - Azores. Terceira translates as "third", the third island to be discovered in the Azores archipelago. It's also the third largest in size. This morning - depart for a view of the Northern Coast. Continue via interior road through Serra do Cume in direction of Biscoitos. Enjoy a luncheon at a typical restaurant in the village of Port Judeu. Then to Algar do Carvao grotto. The **Algar do Carvão** is an ancient lava tube or volcanic vent located in the center of the island. Visit the the natural swimming pools of black volcanic rock in Biscoitos. Return via villages of Altares, and Reminho Serreta, passing Doze Ribeiras, Santa Barbara and S. Mateus to arrive at Angra do Heroismo. Evening at leisure – There may be a “Festa” nearby with bullfights on a rope. If not, relax by the pool. **(B, L)**

Jun 19 - Half day tour of Angra. On our leisurely walk, you will visit the majestic 19th century City Hall, and the historical Town Square. A guided tour at the Angra Museum. Tells the history of the city and island as well as having an impressive collection of arms, maps, painting and sculpture. Afterwards, a short stroll around the peaceful and charming *Jardim Duque da Terceira*, is a manicured garden in the center of [Angra do Heroísmo](#). Afternoon at leisure. – check out nearby shopping, or just relax by the pool. **Tonight we enjoy a special farewell dinner to celebrate the success of your journey! (B, D)**
